## Scholarship Application Checklist

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### Submission Components:

1. **Essay:** A typewritten, double-spaced essay (500 words minimum) addressing one of the application questions. Please title your essay.
2. **Financial Statement:** A double-spaced statement explaining how this scholarship will benefit you. Please title this document.
3. **Identification:** A copy of your photo ID or driver's license.
4. **Transcript:** An unofficial transcript showing your current cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above (unweighted).
5. **Acceptance Letter:** An acceptance letter from an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university you plan to attend. Note: You may apply before being accepted, but the scholarship will not be awarded until your acceptance is confirmed in writing.
6. **Photograph:** A recent photograph of yourself (e.g., school photo or senior picture). This photo will be printed in the scholarship souvenir book and will not be returned.
7. **Counselor Information:** Include your guidance counselor's name and your school's telephone number.
8. **Complete Application:** Ensure that all lines and questions on the application are filled out. Altered applications will be disqualified.
9. **Letters of Recommendation:** Two letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with your personal attributes and extracurricular/community involvement (excluding parents and relatives).
10. **Scholarship Luncheon:** If selected, you must attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony Presentation.

**Scholarship Value:** \$1,000

*Note: Scholarship recipients may be selected before gaining acceptance to a 2 or 4-year institution. However, funds will not be distributed until you provide written confirmation of your acceptance. This scholarship is specifically for students pursuing a degree in education to become a Classroom Teacher (Pre-K - 12) **OR** Vocational Technical Field (LPN, HVAC). Examples of how to describe a teaching degree: "Bachelor of Arts in Education" or "Degree in Elementary/Secondary Education".*
